

The Cheer Coach will be responsible for developing the varsity program for Mount Clemens Community Schools. The coach will work with student-athletes to build foundational skills, foster teamwork, and promote sportsmanship. The ideal candidate will have experience in coaching and will be dedicated to creating a positive, inclusive, and supportive environment for all players.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities – Other duties may be assigned:

- Recruit and select members of the team.
- Develop and implement an age-appropriate conditioning program focusing on skill development, team strategies, and individual growth.
- Teach fundamentals of the sport.
- Monitor team members' academic progress (weekly).
- Distribute and collect uniforms and equipment.
- Provide first aid, as needed.
- Attend all meetings required by the Athletic Director and/or Building Principal.
- Direct and supervise all team practices and events.
- Complete all required reports in a timely manner.
- Ability to monitor student classroom academic progress.
- Participate in the Athletic Banquet.
- Communicate effectively with students, parents, and school staff regarding practice schedules, team expectations, and performance.
- Ensure a safe and inclusive environment for all players.
- Uphold school values and enforce sportsmanship and discipline on and off the court.
- Assist with organizing and attending team events, meetings, and fundraising activities as needed.



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Qualifications:

- Previous experience playing or coaching preferred.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to inspire, motivate, and mentor student-athletes.
- Ability to work collaboratively with school administration, staff, and parents.
- Certification in First Aid/CPR and coaching (or willingness to obtain).
