- Conduct initial screenings for students with identified behavioral needs due to trauma, social or emotional needs.
- Perform comprehensive SSW evaluations and re-evaluations for students that may qualify for special education or are already on special education caseload.
- Basic knowledge of Individual Education Plan, Initial or Re-Evaluation Meeting, Student Study Team,
 Multi-Evaluation Team Meeting, Functional Behavior Assessment and Behavior Improvement Plan.
- Able to effectively communicate with students, staff, parents and outside support resources.
 Uphold the school discipline plan while providing students with clear expectations, a system of positive reinforcement and sequential, consistent, progressive consequences.
- Fosters, recognizes, and supports ethnic, cultural, gender, economic, and human diversity within the classroom and school community.
- coordinating with building staff and MISD Homeless Coordinator to ensure homeless students are identified and support services are implemented.
- Performs other functions and duties as assigned by the Superintendent or designee.

- Preferred Masters of Social Work, Masters level Michigan State Social Work License, Certificate as a School Social Worker endorsement through the State of Michigan from an accredited college.
- Clear criminal history check, physical, and drug test, required; first aid training.
